

# WAG 2009 SAILPLANE GRANPRIX

### Foreword:

The World Air Games Organizing Committee is pleased to announce the organization of the WAG Torino 2009 Sailplane Grand Prix from June 6th to June 14th 2009 at Torino Aeritalia airfield. This Grand Prix will be included in the World Air Games. This event is reserved to the top gliding pilot defined by IGC.

### Glider Competition Classes:

Only Gliders of the 15m and Standard FAI classes will be admitted. To narrow any performance difference between the 15m and Standard gliders there will be a maximum wing loading limit of 50kgs/sq meter.

### Contest Area:

The Torino WAG Sailplane Grand Prix contest area includes all of NW Italy from the Susa Valley to the lakes Region. This area provides potential to enjoy the conditions from the highest Alpine peaks to the flat land south of Torino.

### Rules:

The Torino WAG Sailplane Grand Prix will be held in accordance with the IGC Rules for Sailplane Grand Prix. The athletes will compete in the first four races which acts as preliminary rounds to select the top 8 pilots. Those will play the final the last day of the event. The preliminary round does not attribute any score for the final. The winner of the final will hold the title of "2009 World Air Games Grand Prix Winner"
